

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One day whilst I was in prayer, I had the Bible opened and was meditating upon the word and praying the scriptures. One of the scriptures caught my attention.

Romans 3:25

"Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past through the forbearance of God".

The words "faith in His blood" began to speak to me. At that very moment the Holy Spirit impressed in my spirit the need to have faith in His blood.

Faith only comes through one way, which is the word of God.

Romans 10:17

"So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God".

Therefore, in order for us to walk in faith in His blood, we need to continually hear from the word what the blood of Jesus has done for us.

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This is the reason why the Spirit of God inspired me to write about the 31 revelations of the blood.

As you read it every day, it will build faith in your heart and you will know the power of the blood of Jesus.



The Blood of Jesus Christ Made the Way The Word of God is comprised of covenants.

God's dealings with man have always been through covenants.

God Almighty has given us a covenant to show forth His utmost commitment to us through the terms of the covenant.

Covenant gives a child of God the assurance of His steadfastness to us.

Psalm 89:28

"My mercy will I keep for him for evermore and my covenant shall stand fast with him."

Psalm 89:34

"My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips."



A covenant is a strong agreement or a contract between two parties which needs to be ratified.





The way God's covenants were ratified was through the shedding of the blood.

- Abram in Genesis 15:7-18 entered into a covenant through the shedding of blood.
- Abram in Genesis 17:9-11 establishes a covenant through the shedding of the blood.

Almighty God declares in:

Psalm 50:5

"Gather my saints together unto me: those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice."

Today we have a better covenant based upon better promises.

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Hebrews 8:6

"But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises." ക്കോ

One of the reasons that we have a better covenant is because the New Covenant was ratified by the blood of God's Son.

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This is clearly explained in:

Hebrews 9:12 "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us."

In the Old Covenant when Aaron entered into the Holy of Holies, he entered with the blood of substitute, being the blood of the animals. There was forgiveness, not cleansing from sin. God looked away, in other words He turned His face away.

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Under the New Covenant, when the Son of God Jesus Christ entered into the holy place, the sin was not just covered, it was put away. He entered with His own blood as man Christ.

That is why He guarantees the New Covenant.





Hebrews 7:22

"By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better testament."

As we journey through this book I want you to understand the living eternal power of the blood of Jesus Christ.


Romans 10:17 says,

Romans 3:25

"Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God."






The Blood of Jesus Christ Cleanses Us "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin."

The word 'cleansing' means to make clean, to purify, to remove any physical stains and dirt.

The Word of God states that the blood of Jesus Christ has the power to make us clean, to purify us and to remove any physical stain or dirt that we have through sin.

1 John 1:7 states the blood cleanseth. That means it is in the present tense. I am sure you will be glad and joyful to know that the blood of Jesus Christ which was shed for you two thousand years ago is cleansing you right now.

In order for the blood of Jesus to cleanse us, 1 John 1:7 gives us certain conditions.







The Word clearly states that the blood cleanses us from all sin. The words 'all sin' are important. We must be conscious that the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin. When we have a consciousness of the blood of Jesus, it removes from us the consciousness of guilt.

Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ, the Son of living God cleanseth me from all sin."

Amen







The Blood of Jesus Christ Provides Us Forgiveness Ephesians 1:7

"In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace"

The blood of Jesus provides us forgiveness for our offences, shortcomings and trespasses.

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What a liberating thought to know that God provided for you and me His Son's blood, so that we can be forgiven.

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In the Old Covenant they had to use the blood of animals to cover their sin and to be forgiven – not on a permanent basis. The offering was a substitute and the effect of the offering was temporary.

The Word of God clearly states in:

1 John 1: 9

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

Now, we have a better covenant through the blood of Jesus. The New Covenant provides us with forgiveness.





A forgiven heart carries no guilt and has the ability and the divine power to forgive others.



Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has forgiven me."

Amen







The Blood of Jesus Christ has Redeemed Us

Ephesians 1:7

"In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace."

Redemption is a legal word. It means a price has been paid to buy back a property.

The blood of Jesus paid the price for us to be redeemed.

Leviticus 17:11

"For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul."


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When Jesus Christ shed His blood, He paid the price of redemption for our soul by giving His soul as a ransom.

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Because of the blood of Jesus, you have been purchased by God to enjoy life.





Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God said in:

John 10:10

"The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly."

Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has redeemed me."

The Blood of Jesus Christ has Translated Us Into the Kingdom of God "Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: 14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins."

The power of the blood took us out of darkness. Before we were redeemed by the blood we were under the dominion of the devil. His Kingdom is the Kingdom of darkness.

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The power and the price of the blood of Jesus translated us from the dominion and the power of the devil to the Kingdom of Light (Kingdom of God).

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I want you to see that the blood of Jesus has changed your position.

Now you stand in a Kingdom ruled and reigned by God's Son, Jesus Christ.

In the kingdom of God there is no calamity, no bondage, no sickness; freedom and liberty is the way of life.





So God, through the blood of His Son has translated you from:

- 1. Bondage to freedom
- 2. Calamity to peace
- 3. Sickness and disease to health
- 4. Death to life
- 5. Tragedy to safety
- 6. Lack to abundance
- 7. Curse to the blessing of Abraham
- 8. Sorrow to joy and peace




Let us declare:

The Blood of Jesus Christ Justifies Us Romans 5:9

"Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him."


The word 'justified' means just as. The Word of God is saying to us, because of the blood of Jesus we are justified; just as if we have never sinned.

It is only the blood of Jesus that can justify an individual. The Word clearly states that we all have sinned.

Romans 3:23

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

Therefore we need to be justified by the blood of Jesus to be in right standing with God.



Justification through the blood of Jesus sets us free from works. We are not justified by our own works; we are justified because of the shed blood of Jesus.





The truth of justification through the blood of Jesus must continually be in our thoughts and consciousness. This will set us free from negative thoughts that the enemy tries to bring upon us.




Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has justified me, just as if I have never sinned."

The Blood of Jesus Christ has Reconciled Us "And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven."

The word 'reconcile' means to change from one condition to another, so as to remove all enmity and leave no impediment to unity and peace.

The blood of Jesus Christ has removed all enmity between God and man, so that we can be reconciled to Him.

Reconciliation restores our position with God and in God.

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Because of the blood of Jesus we are brought into the position of sonship with the Almighty God and God dwells in us.

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When we are reconciled to God through the blood of Jesus Christ, our hearts become filled with God's unconditional love, so that we can reach out to others, having a ministry of reconciliation.



Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has reconciled me."







The Blood of Jesus Christ has Given Us Peace with God "And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven."

I want you to think of the phrase "Peace with God".

When God created man, He created him to have fellowship with Him. As the Word of God says, God was looking for Adam in the cool of the day.

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When man sinned and disobeyed God, he lost his union and communion with God. There became a separation between God and man because God is holy.

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Man's sin kept him from entering into the Holy of Holies; God's dwelling place. Man was barred from the Holy of Holies by the Ten Commandments.

True peace can only reign in our hearts when we have made peace with our Master. That is why we see so many individuals who have fame, money and position but they have no peace. Why? They have not accepted the Prince of Peace who shed His blood to give them peace with God.



31 Revelations shour the Blood of Jesus Christ


We have peace with God because we have faith in the shed blood of Jesus and we received the Prince of Peace, our Lord and Saviour.

Let us declare:

"Jesus Christ has made peace with God for me and my household through His blood in Jesus Name."

"The blood of Jesus Christ has given me and my household peace with God."

has Given Us
Access to the
Throne of God

Hebrews 10:19

"Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus."

In the Old Covenant we see that the Holy of Holies was not accessible to anyone apart from the High Priest who entered once a year.

The High Priest had to comply to strict rules and regulations that needed to be fulfilled in order to enter the Holy of Holies where God's presence dwelt.

Failing to comply with the Law would result in the death of the High Priest. This gives us a clear picture of the holiness of God and also the fact that sin separates us from God's presence.

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When Jesus Christ shed His blood and became the perfect sacrifice on the cross for our sin, the way was open to access God's throne through His blood.

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I want you to remember the word 'boldness' in Hebrews 10:19.





We do not have to worship God from afar anymore. We can enter into the Holy of Holies through the blood of His Son.



That is why the Word of God states in:

Ephesians 2:19

"Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God."

The blood of Jesus Christ has brought us from the outer court into the inner court.

Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus has given me access to the throne of God at any time and in any place in Jesus Name."

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The Blood
of Jesus Christ
has the Power
to Purge
Our Conscience

"How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"

In our memory bank we have two sets of data. One which is lodged in our conscience and the other in our sub-conscience.

The memory data that is in our conscience, we are able to access at our own will and at anytime.

The memory data that is in our subconscious we are not able to access at will. It is only accessible by an event or situation which triggers the memory in the subconscious. For example, when you hear a certain song, you immediately remember the place where you were when you first heard it and also the events that occurred during that time.

Some memories that are in our sub-conscious are good and some are bad. Many individuals fall into fear, anger and temptation through ungodly memories that are lodged in their sub-conscious.

The only element that washes all the dead and unproductive memories in our conscience is the blood of Jesus.






When our conscience is clear, we will begin to see God's purpose and His will for our lives clearly. That is why the Word states the blood can purge our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.



Let us declare:

"I apply the cleansing power of the blood of Jesus to my mind, memory cells, conscious and subconscious to purge all dead works to serve the living God."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Has Made Us Nigh

Ephesians 2:13

"But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ."

We were far away and alienated from the presence of God. When you are far away from God you are not able to enjoy the goodness of God.

Sin separated us from God. There was a separation between man and God.

Ephesians 2:14

"For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us."



Through the sacrifice on the cross, Jesus Christ has destroyed the separation whereby we can enjoy the presence of God.



Sin also brought enmity against God. Once again His sacrifice has abolished the enmity and translated us nigh to God.



That is why Ephesians 2:19 states:

"Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God."

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Because the blood of Jesus Christ has brought us nigh we are able to enjoy the legal right of being the household of God.

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Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus has brought me nigh and made me the household of God."







The Blood
of Jesus Christ
Made it Possible
For Us to Commune
in the Blood

"The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ"

Remember, when we take communion in accordance with:

1 Corinthians 11:23-25

"For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me." 25 In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."

We are in commune with the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.

This union and communion is deeper and is of a life giving nature whereby our hearts are knit together with the heart of God.





There is no closer union and communion with the Lord than the commune in the blood.



That is why we read in the book of Acts chapter 2:42 onwards, that as the apostles broke bread from house to house and celebrated the union with God, He began to bless them.

The blood of Christ knits our hearts with the heart of God.

Let us declare:

"I have communion in the blood of God's Son; therefore my heart is knit with the heart of God."







The Blood
of Jesus Christ
Connects and
Keeps Us
in the Covenant

"Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant."

A covenant is a strong binding agreement. The Word of God contains two covenants; the Old Covenant and the New Covenant.



All covenants require four basic elements:

- 1. It is binding
- 2. It is holy
- 3. It must be ratified
- If a covenant is broken there is a penalty



The New Covenant, the better covenant was ratified by the blood of Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 9:12

"Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us."



Hebrews 8:6

"But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises."

The blood of Jesus brought us into an everlasting, better covenant. The blood keeps us in that covenant.



Every time we declare the blood of Jesus Christ, the blood reminds God Almighty of the covenant we have with Him through His Son.

Remember, all of God's blessings can only be appropriated through the covenant.



Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has brought me into an everlasting better covenant and it keeps me in that covenant."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Has Made Us Priests and Kings "And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth.

Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, 6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion forever and ever.

Amen."

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The blood of Jesus Christ has taken us out of the pit and has elevated us to be kings and priests unto God.

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In the book of Hebrews the Word says that He is able to save us to the uttermost. I once heard someone say that the Lord had lifted him from the guttermost to the uttermost.

The blood of Jesus has the power to lift us up.

Hebrews 8:25

"Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them."





As a priest we are to worship, honour and serve God. As a king we rule righteously.

The blood of Jesus Christ has given us a position in life.



Remember, it does not matter what your earthly position is, the blood of Jesus has obtained for you and me a heavenly position which is eternal.

Jesus our Lord washed our sins with His own blood to make us kings and priests unto His Father.

What a glorious redeemer our Lord is.

Let us declare:

"Thank you Lord that through Your blood You have made me a king and a priest unto Your Father and my God."





"And from Jesus Christ,
who is the faithful witness,
and the first begotten of the dead,
and the prince of the kings
of the earth. Unto him that
loved us, and washed us
from our sins in his own blood,
6 And hath made us kings and
priests unto God and his Father;
to him be glory and dominion
forever and ever. Amen."



The Blood of Jesus Christ Gives Us the Power to Overcome

Revelation 12:11

"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death."

The above verse clearly states that the blood of Jesus is one of the elements that is needed to overcome the devil.

Let me state the above scripture in a manner that we will all be able to remember and apply.

"I overcome Satan by personally testifying what the Word says the blood of Jesus does for me."

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When we declare what the Word of God says the blood of Jesus does for us, it gives us faith and power to overcome.





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Remember, we are overcomers through His Word and His blood.

So God has placed in our hands a divine weapon, a weapon that has the power to destroy the work of the devil and give us the ability to overcome. The divine weapon is the blood of Jesus.

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2 Corinthians 10:4

"For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds."

Let us declare:

"I overcome Satan by declaring what the Word says the blood of Jesus does for me."

I have been redeemed by the blood from sickness, disease and plagues into divine health.

Colossians 1:13-14

"Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son. 14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:"

I thank You that the blood of Jesus speaks mercy and grace for me and my household.

Hebrews 12:24

"And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel."

Amen

Above are some of the examples of how you can declare the blood. As you take hold of all the revelations of the blood of Jesus in the Word of God and begin to declare them, faith and power will be born in your life to overcome.





The Blood of Jesus Christ Has Given Us Eternal Life John 6:53-54

"Then Jesus said unto them,
Verily, verily, I say unto you,
Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and
drink his blood, ye have no life in you. 54
Whoso eateth my flesh,
and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and
I will raise him up at the last day."

The blood of Jesus has given us eternal life. Many Christians do not have the concept that they have eternal life.

1 John 5:13

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

The above scripture clearly states that we have eternal life. What is eternal life?

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Life that is not separated from God, whereby our lives are interwoven with the life of God.





The blood of Jesus has brought eternity into our lives. We will spend eternity in God's presence.

1 John 5:11

"And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son."

The blood of Jesus has made it possible for us to have and enjoy the life of the Son of God.

Remember, God is not eternal but eternity dwells in Him. Through the blood of Jesus we become partakers of that eternal life of God.

Let us declare:

"Through the blood of Jesus I have eternal life."





"Then Jesus said unto them,
Verily, verily, I say unto you,
Except ye eat the flesh of the Son
of man, and drink his blood,
ye have no life in you.
54 Whoso eateth my flesh,
and drinketh my blood,
hath eternal life; and I will
raise him up at the last day."



The Blood of Jesus Christ Has Broken Enmity between God and Man "But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. 14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us 15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; 16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby."

God created Adam to have fellowship with Him. That is why the Word says that God would come to see His prized creation Adam in the cool of the day to have communion with Him.

When Adam disobeyed God, he substituted God's will with his will. That was the beginning of sin and rebelliousness.

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Sin and rebelliousness separates humanity from God and His love. The sinful nature and the rebelliousness nature are natures that do not allow God's will to reign in a life.





Jesus Christ the Son of the Living God has come to fulfil the Law. Why did He fulfil the Law? God had to introduce the Law to make humanity realize that they were of a sinful, rebellious nature and the consequences of it were enmity between man and God. Man was not capable of keeping the Law and in the Old Covenant they had to offer sacrifices every year to atone for their sin.



God's Son came and fulfilled the Law and died on the cross to break the enmity that existed between man and God.


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That is why today you can call God your heavenly Father.

Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has broken the enmity between me and God. The blood of Jesus has established a living relationship between me and God."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Sanctifies Us Hebrews 13:12

"Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate."

The word 'sanctify' means to make one holy but it also means to separate.

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The blood of Jesus not only made us holy by washing away our sins but it separated us to worship, honour and serve God.

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The blood of Christ has sanctified us for God's purpose.

In the Old Covenant the altar and the offering had to be sanctified.

Exodus 29:37

"Seven days thou shalt make an atonement for the altar, and sanctify it; and it shall be an altar most holy: whatsoever toucheth the altar shall be holy."

We see in the above scripture that the altar had to be sanctified by blood for it to be holy for God's purpose.



In the New Covenant we see the cross of Calvary as the ultimate altar where God's Son was sacrificed. The blood of the Son of God not only sanctified the altar but also everyone who will accept and receive the perfect sacrifice on the cross.

The altar was sanctified by the blood of Jesus and the offering is sanctified by the altar.




When we surrender our lives to Christ, His blood that was shed on the cross for us sanctifies us for God's purpose.

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Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has sanctified me and set me apart to honour, worship and serve the living God."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Makes Us Perfect in the Sight of God Hebrews 10:14

"For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified."

We learn that the blood of Jesus has sanctified us. Sanctification by the blood makes one holy.

The Apostle Peter states
in the Word: 1 Peter 1:16
"Because it is written.
Be ye holy for I am holy."

What makes us holy is not our righteousness but the righteousness of our Lord Jesus. He gave us His righteousness by shedding His very blood on the cross of Calvary.

When we are clothed in His righteousness and covered by His blood it elevates our position from the natural to the supernatural.

When God the Father looks upon us He sees our new found position in Christ which is perfect because of the blood of Jesus. That is why the Word of God declares:




1 Peter 2:9

"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:"

Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus has not only sanctified me, it has also made me perfect in the sight of God."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Brings the Manifestation of the Holy Spirit "For there are three that bear record in beaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. 8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one."

As God the Father, Son, the Word and the Holy Ghost bear record in heaven, similarly the Spirit, the blood and the water being the Word of God, agrees on earth.

What a tremendous revelation when you know that the Holy Spirit bears witness to the blood of Jesus.

The blood that our Master shed is not ordinary blood. This is unique, heavenly blood full of power and life. It is the Holy Spirit that bears witness to our spirit about the divine work of the blood of Jesus.

In order for the Spirit of God to bear witness to the blood of Jesus, the blood must be appropriated and declared.





The moment we declare what the Word says the blood of Jesus does for us, the Holy Ghost comes with the power of heaven to demonstrate and to manifest that truth.



The spirit manifests His full power and works effectively among us only through the blood. What a glorious blood that summons the Spirit of God to be present.

Let us declare:

"As I declare the blood of Jesus and its attributes upon me, my household, my situation and circumstances, the blessed Holy Spirit comes to manifest the resurrection power."





"For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. 8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood:

and these three agree in one."



The Blood of Jesus Christ has Given Us the Indwelling Spirit "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us."

The reason for eternal redemption is that man can become a habitation of heaven.

What a great salvation our Lord has provided for us. Man born in sin, shaped in iniquity, forgiven, cleansed, purified outside and inside by the precious blood of Jesus to be made a habitation of God.



Paul, the Apostle reminds us in: 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?"

The purpose of the blood of Jesus is to make us the habitation of God.



The outpouring of the blood was followed by the outpouring of the Spirit. The blood is the life of man. The spirit is the life of God.



Ephesians 2:22

"In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit."

Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus has made me a habitation of God. I have become the temple of the Holy Spirit."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Gives Us Access to the Promises of God "And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance."

Eternal inheritance was obtained through redemption.



Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God paid with His own blood to redeem humanity. Having redeemed them, He gave to those who believe and receive Him as their Saviour, the promise of eternal inheritance.

The word 'eternal' not only means something that continues and has no end, but it also means it has no beginning and knows no change or decay.

The substance or life of eternity is independent of time because it is God's and He does not live in the realm of time. Everything that exists in time has a beginning and an end and is subject to the Law of increase and decrease.



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
The blood of Jesus has obtained eternal inheritance that is always glorious. Our promise of inheritance is secure and it will never change.

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Let us declare:

"The blood of Jesus Christ has given us access to the promise of eternal inheritance."







Holy Spirit
Bears Witness to the
Power of the
Blood of Jesus Christ

"How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"

The above scripture clearly indicates that the eternal Spirit of God waits, always ready to demonstrate to us the power that is in the blood of Jesus.

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The power of the blood was brought forth by the Spirit of God to cleanse, sanctify and purge us and our conscience.

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Our Lord stated in John 15:26

"But when the comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me."

Yes, the Comforter has arrived because of the shed blood of Christ. Think about the power of the blood of Jesus which brought God to dwell in man and man to be lifted into heavenly places.



As our Lord said, it is the work of the blessed Spirit to testify of Jesus and all that Jesus has done including His shed blood.



Let us declare:

"Lord by Your Spirit, reveal to my heart the power of the blood of Jesus so that I will walk a victorious life on earth. As You have overcome, I will also be an overcomer in You Lord. I ask and receive it in Jesus precious Name."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Cleanses the Heavens

Hebrews 9:23

"It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these".

When the word of God talks about heavens, it includes the atmosphere, the realm where the demonic spiritual forces operate and also the place where God dwells.

Even though we cannot see into the heavenly places there is a tremendous amount of activity that is taking place in this realm.

2 Corinthians 4:18

"While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal."

This clearly tells us there are two worlds, the spiritual and the natural.

Daniel 10:13

"But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia".



The answer was delayed by twenty-one days because of the demonic activity in the heavenlies.

Thank God today we have the precious blood of Jesus which is able to cleanse the heavenlies.

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We must continue to declare
the precious blood of Jesus
in the heavenlies, so that
the heavenly realm above us
will be cleansed and sanctified
but it will also bring
the enemy's plans to nought.

Let us declare:

"Lord, I take the precious blood of Jesus which is able to sanctify and cleanse. I declare the blood of Jesus and cleanse and sanctify the heavenlies over my city and also the places my family and I may enter this day and night."





The Blood of Jesus Christ Speaks for Us

Hebrews 12:24

"And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel."

The word of God clearly states that the blood speaks. The writer of Hebrews wants us to know the clear distinction between the blood of Abel and the blood of Jesus Christ.

The blood of Abel and the blood of Jesus Christ speak, but the word says the blood of Jesus Christ speaks better things.

Let me give you a comparison so that you will begin to realise the importance of the blood of Jesus.

- Abel's blood was spilt.
 Jesus Christ shed His blood.
- Abel did not lay down his life willingly, he was murdered.

Jesus Christ willingly gave His life; therefore He shed His blood willingly for humanity.

- The blood of Abel was spilt on earth.The blood of Jesus was offered in heaven.
- The blood of Abel speaks vengeance.
 The blood of Jesus speaks mercy.



There is a voice that continues to speak for you and me. That voice is the blood of Jesus. It cries mercy for us.

There are so many voices in the world that speak against us, but remember what the blood of Jesus speaks for you and me is greater than all the negative words.



Let us declare:

"Lord Jesus I thank You for Your blood which speaks for me and my household day and night. It speaks mercy and grace for us."







The Blood of Jesus Christ is the Blood of God "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, for which He hath purchased with His own blood."

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The Church belongs to God.
The church is not a denomination
or a building. The church is the body
of Christ. That is you and me.
How did we become part of the
body of Christ? Through God's blood.

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Jesus Christ, the Son of the Living God is divine. He is God. God shed His own blood to purchase us.

The blood of Jesus is no ordinary blood. It is pure incorruptible blood.

Leviticus 17:11

"For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul".



When God shed His blood on the cross, He gave His life for you and me.

Remember you have been purchased and redeemed by God's blood. The price was paid in full for your liberty and freedom.

Let us declare:

"Thank You Father for the blood of Your Son, Jesus. The blood that redeemed me and my household is the blood of God. The blood of God is divine and holy."








The Blood of Jesus Christ and the Cross "And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven."

The Apostle Paul uses the word blood of His cross. There is great significance to this statement. He was stating that it was only through the blood, the power and effectiveness of the cross was revealed.

The cross without the blood of Christ has no power or effect on any human being. It is the blood of Christ that reveals the effect and power of the finished work of the cross to every human soul.



Christ on the cross displayed to us the love of God. The blood united us to Christ and His great love.

The blood of Christ is the earthly token of the heavenly power and glory of God's love.






The blood of Christ points us to the finished work of the cross and to the great exchange that took place for humanity on the cross of Calvary.



Let us declare:

"Lord I want to thank You that through the blood of Christ, You will reveal and impart to me and my household, the power and the effect of the finished work of the cross of Calvary."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Sanctified the Altar "Seven days thou shalt make atonement for the altar, and sanctify it; and it shall be an altar most holy: whatsoever toucheth the altar shall be holy."

Everything that we bring to God must be holy and sanctified because he is a holy God. One of the most important articles of furniture in the tabernacle was the altar. The altar was used to present sacrifices to God.



In order for God to accept the offering, not only must the offering be sanctified, but also the altar upon which the sacrifice is placed.

The blood of the sacrifice sanctified the altar, thereafter the offering was sanctified by the altar.



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Today we have the blood of the perfect sacrificed Lamb of God which is able to sanctify, not only the offerings that we bring to God, but also the heavenly altar forevermore.


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Let us declare:

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


The Blood

"Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, in the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for a house."

In the Old Covenant, when God Almighty wanted to bring the children of Israel out of bondage, He instructed them to celebrate the Passover.

In preparation for the Passover, they had to take a lamb which would be killed during Passover. This lamb would represent the entire household.



1 Corinthians 5:7

"Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us".





When Jesus Christ died on the cross and shed His blood it was not just for you and me, it was for our household. The blood of Jesus protects our household.



Let us declare:

"The precious blood of Jesus protects me and my household. It will keep me and my household in divine health, divine provision, and divine protection."







The Blood of Jesus Christ Averted the Eternal Danger "Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son. In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins."

Sin has separated man. Sin brought a change of relationship between God with man, and also man with God

With man, it resulted in his fall and enmity against God. With God, it resulted in His turning away from man or His wrath.

This is a terrible picture of the danger of being separated from God Almighty.

A man who is separated from God is lost for eternity. He will have no place to hide from the wrath of God.

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When God's Son died on the cross and shed His very blood, He brought a change of relationship between God with man and man with God. The Eternal danger was averted. Man's enmity against God was broken and God's wrath against man was removed.




Ephesians 2:16-17

"And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby: And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh."

> What a precious Lamb of God who has averted the eternal danger from mankind.

Let us declare:

"I thank You Lord for the blood of Jesus. The blood has broken all enmity that I and my household had against God and it has removed God's wrath over our lives."





The Blood of Jesus Christ Obtains the Blessings "And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt."

The children of Israel knew when they had applied the blood on the house they were safe. God promised them that destruction would not come to their household. The word of God says, "When I see the blood, I will pass over you".

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The blood of the Passover Lamb redeemed them from destruction and brought heaven's blessings upon them.

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Psalms 105:37

"He brought them forth also with silver and gold and there was not one feeble person among their tribes."

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How much more we, who now do not have the blood of an earthly lamb but the blood of the Lamb of God, are assured and guaranteed of the blessings of heaven.



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
I would like to relate this story that is recorded of an incident that may have taken place during the Passover in Egypt.

An old Israeli lived with his firstborn son. He himself was the firstborn son of his father. His son also had a firstborn son. Therefore, there were three firstborns in the same house.

Exodus 11:5

"And all the firstborn in the Land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts".

The old man was sick and he was lying on his bed. He heard all that the son said to the household about God's instruction to Moses. Towards the evening of that day he became restless and began to question his son asking him, "Have you done everything correctly according to God's instruction?" The son would reply, "Yes father". For a moment he was satisfied. Again he will repeat the same question to his son. The closer it came to midnight the father became more and more restless. Finally he cried out, "Son, carry me out before midnight. I want to see the blood of the lamb on the doorpost". The son took his father and showed him. The father began to cry and thank God, "Now I can rest because I know I am safe".



Let us declare:

"The blood of the Lamb of God has given me the assurance that all God's blessings will be on me and my household."



If you want to appropriate the blessings of what Jesus Christ has done, and would like to become a Christian, then I would like you to say this prayer with a believing heart:




















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
